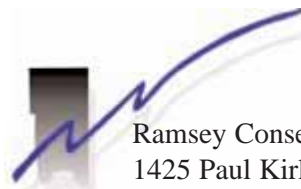

The Ramsey Conservation District is sponsoring a 2 hour workshop on lakescaping and shoreline restoration. Conservation specialists Shawn Tracy and Ryan Johnson will share examples of restored shorelines, the how-to behind it, and available cost share for 2009.
