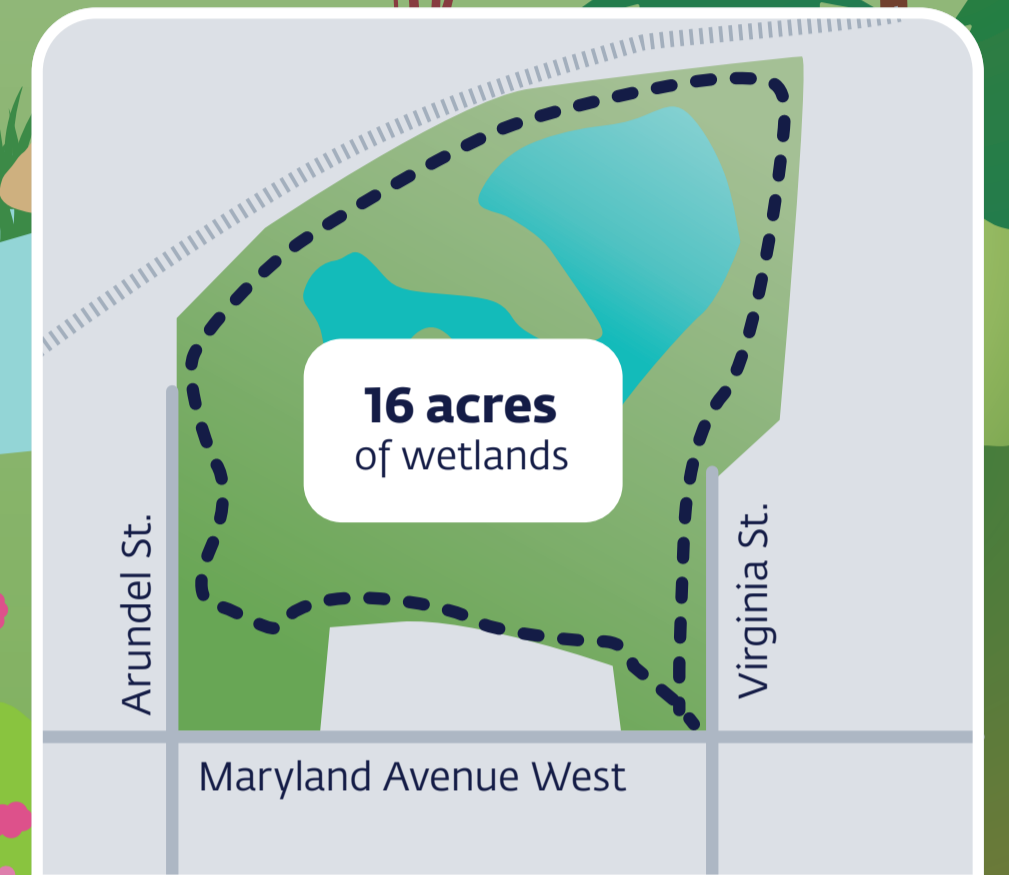


A Historic Stream

A pond fed by a storm sewer pipe stores extra water during heavy rainstorms to prevent flooding in the neighboring community.
