Permit Process Timeline

Applicants are encouraged to submit their applications and plans prior to the 21 day deadline. Staff are available to meet and discuss preliminary plans and to answer any questions regarding compliance with CRWD Rules.

Days Before CRWD Board Meeting	Activity
21	Permit applications and required exhibits are due by 4:30 pm. Applications received by the deadline are reviewed by staff for compliance with District rules.
12-14	If time allows, preliminary comments may be forwarded to applicants to make necessary revisions.
7-9	Revised plans and/or additional information received by District staff will be considered before staff makes a final recommendation to CRWD's Board of Managers.
6	Staff recommendations are distributed to the CRWD Board and permit applicants. Applications that do not meet standards within CRWD rules may be presented at a subsequent meeting.
0	Board meeting is held and action is taken on permits with approval recommendations.
